## Places of interest in and around Delhi

**Bahai Temple.** Situated atop the Kalkaji Hill. Its is also known as "The Lotus Temple: due to its distinctive lotus shaped design in Marble. It was built in 1987 by the followers of Bahai faith. The temple signifies the purity and equality of all religions.

**Qutub Minar.** It was built in the early 13th century by Qutab ud din Aibak, and was later finished by his son-in-law Iltutmish. It is one of the earliest and most prominent examples of Indo-Islamic architecture. This minaret is covered with intricate carvings and verses from Quran.

**Rashtrapati Bhavan .**The splendour of the Rashtrapati Bhavan is multi-dimensional. More than these, it has a hallowed existence in the annals of democracy for being the residence of the President of the largest democracy in the world. Few official residential premises of the Head of the State in the world will match the Rashtrapati Bhavan in terms of its size, vastness and its magnificence.



**Akshardham Temple.** It is also referred to as Delhi Akshardham or Swami Narayan Akshardham. AKSHARDHAM means the eternal, divine abode of supreme God. The temple was built in 5 years and the most wonderful thing about it is that no steel was used in the making of this monument; it is only composed of sandstone and marble. One can also enjoy musical fountain here.

**Taj Mahal.** It has been recently voted as first among the seven new modern wonders of the world. Taj Mahal was constructed by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of immortal love for his wife, Mumtaz Mahal.
